*Originally named in honor of the firm's third founding partner, Herman Mintz, our diversity scholarship was renamed in 2011 to honor Richard Mintz, Herman's son. Richard was a beloved partner in the firm for many years. Deeply committed to diversity, community service, and the Mintz Levin family, he embodied the soul of the firm.*

*Mintz Levin was founded in 1933, a time when it was almost impossible for a woman or member of a minority group to thrive at one of Boston's larger law offices. The firm's commitment to diversity is a natural outgrowth of our founders' struggle to carve out a more inclusive professional path — a history that helps to explain why we have long been dedicated to celebrating the differences that create a vibrant and welcoming atmosphere in which to practice law.*

### Applying for the 2012 Richard Mintz Diversity Scholarship

The Mintz Levin Scholarship Committee is looking for a first-year law student from a diverse background who has demonstrated excellence in his or her studies, is community-minded, and has a commitment to diversity.

### Scholarship Benefits

The recipient of the Richard Mintz Diversity Scholarship will receive:

- \$10,000 toward tuition for the second year of law school
- A paid summer position in Mintz Levin's Boston or New York office between the first and second years of law school
- A continuing working relationship with the firm throughout the second law school year

In addition, the recipient will work with the chair of Mintz Levin's Pro Bono Committee to structure a unique program combining exposure to traditional law firm work with pro bono assignments in the student's area of interest.
